## **Safeguarding Statement:**

#### **Definition**

Children missing from education are children of compulsory school age who are not registered pupils at a school and are not receiving suitable education otherwise than at school.

## Responsibilities

Effective information sharing between parents, schools and local authorities is critical to ensuring that all children of compulsory school age are safe and receiving suitable education.

We have a legal duty to identify Children Missing from Education (CME) and to make sure they return to education wherever possible.

### How to Report a Child Who is Potentially Absent or Missing from Education

A **Children Missing from Education (CME) referral form** can be completed by a school after a maximum 10 days' absence through a secure email address: **CME@coventry.gov.uk**.

Anyone with a concern that a child is missing from education can make a referral to the Access to Education Team (EMAS).

If the school has submitted a **CME referral form**, the Local Authority must be consulted before a pupil is removed from the school register.
