Open Evening

Medication – forms MUST be completed! Can we please remind parents that if your children requires any medication, this must be passed on to the school office by an adult and a consent to administer medication from the school website must be completed. Children should not bring any medication into school themselves, and without the consent form we are unable to administer any medication. There have been several instances recently where children have presented teachers with medication from their school bag. This should not happen.

We are a 'nut free' school! A reminder that, due to several children and adults in school having severe nut allergies, All Souls is a 'nut free' school. Children should not, therefore, bring into school any items containing nuts as this poses a significant risk vulnerable members of our community. Again - there have been multiple instances recently of children brining nuts to school either as a snack or part of their lunch.

Operation Snap - Dangerous Driving / Parking Outside Schools

Operation Snap is now running in police forces across the country. This operation involves members of the public reporting traffic offences directly to the police team by submitting digital footage or images of an offence via the website. All footage and images are then reviewed, and the police will take action where appropriate. Schools are being asked to share this with parents as there are a significant number of offences which occur outside of schools at peak times. If you see dangerous driving, parking or traffic offences outside of the school and have footage of this, you can now report these via the WMP website linked to below.


