
NSPCC Number Day - Friday 7th February

The option to pay online will be available via School Gateway shortly.







SPORTS NEWS JANUARY 2025

Year 5 and 6 team went up against a very strong St Thomas More side in our first match of 2025. The boys played superb from the very first minute and were extremely unlucky to concede the first goal. Unfortunately, they ended up going into half time 5 nil down. The children didn't let their heads drop and showed great resilience and determination as they carried on competing throughout the 2nd half, drawing the half 4-4, meaning the final result was 9-4 to St Thomas More. Twenty four children from Year 5 and 6 competed against three other schools in the Final of the Coventry Schools Sport Hall Athletics competition.
