#### Minutes of education lost this week through lateness: 270

Attendance remained above 96% last week which was pleasing to see. It would be great if, over the next few weeks, we could get the whole school year-to-date attendance above 96%. Punctuality also improved this week with fewer children arriving late and less than half of the minutes of education lost than the previous week. Let's really try to get this down to zero so that no child's education is impacted by lateness and therefore lack of readiness to learn.

#### Chicken Pox Cases - please be vigilant!

We are currently experiencing a high number of cases of chickenpox which has impacted several classes within the school. Can we ask that all parents are extra vigilant over the coming weeks so that children who have chickenpox (unless all of the spots have formed scabs) do not attend school. Whilst we know that all children will likely catch chickenpox at some point, and that it is a common and largely mild infection, we do have both vulnerable and pregnant members of staff - for whom exposure to chickenpox can be dangerous. Children from Nursery to Year 6 are invited to choose gifts for their mums or other special family members ahead of Mother's Day.


