Sunday Gospel and Reflection

Gospel Reading for Sunday 7th June 2026 – John 6:51-58 (The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ)

At that time: Jesus said to the Jews, 'I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live for ever. And the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh.'

The Jews then disputed among themselves, saying, 'How can this man give us his flesh to eat?'

So Jesus said to them, 'Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you. Whoever feeds on my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever feeds on my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me, and I in him. As the living Father sent me, and I live because of the Father, so whoever feeds on me, he also will live because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven, not like the bread the fathers ate, and died. Whoever feeds on this bread will live for ever.'

Short reflection:

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus says something very special: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven." He tells His followers that He wants to give Himself completely to them so that they can have life and remain close to Him.

These words help us understand the wonderful gift of the Eucharist. At Mass, when we receive Holy Communion, we are not simply remembering Jesus—we are meeting Him in a real and special way. Jesus comes to us as spiritual food, strengthening us with His love and helping us to live as His disciples. For many children in our school, this may bring to mind their First Holy Communion or their preparation to receive this sacrament. The Eucharist reminds us that Jesus wants to be part of our everyday lives, helping us to grow in faith, kindness, and love.

Just as we need food each day to keep our bodies healthy, we need Jesus to nourish our hearts and souls. Through prayer, Mass, and acts of love, we stay connected to Him.

For families, this feast is a beautiful opportunity to reflect on the importance of gathering together. Around the family table we share meals, stories, and laughter. Around the Lord's table, we receive the gift of Jesus Himself and become one family in Christ.

Parents can help children appreciate the Eucharist by talking about what happens at Mass and by encouraging them to see Holy Communion as a gift of friendship with Jesus. This feast reminds us that Jesus is always close to us, feeding us with His love and inviting us to share that love with others.
