# Sunday Gospel and Reflection

**Gospel Reading for Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> June 2026 – Matthew 10:26-33 (12<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year A)**

At that time: Jesus instructed his Apostles: 'Have no fear of them, for nothing is covered that will not be revealed, or hidden that will not be known. What I tell you in the dark, say in the light, and what you hear whispered, proclaim on the housetops. And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell. Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? And not one of them will fall to the ground apart from your Father knowing. But even the hairs of your head are all numbered. Fear not, therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows. So everyone who acknowledges me before men, I also will acknowledge before my Father who is in heaven, but whoever denies me before men, I also will deny before my Father who is in heaven.'

Short reflection:

*In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus says something very reassuring to His disciples: "Do not be afraid." In fact, He repeats these words several times because He knows that everyone, both children and adults, can sometimes feel worried, nervous, or uncertain.*

*Jesus reminds His followers that God knows and loves them completely. He even says that God knows every hair on our heads! This is His way of telling us that every single person is precious and important to God.*

*For children and families, this Gospel is a wonderful reminder that we are never alone. Whether we are facing a difficult piece of schoolwork, making a new friend, trying something for the first time, or dealing with a worry, Jesus is with us every step of the way.*

*Jesus also encourages us not to hide our faith. We can show that we belong to Him not only by praying, but by the way we live each day—through kindness, honesty, courage, and compassion.*

*At home and at school, we can be brave in simple ways:*

*by standing up for someone who is being left out,  
by telling the truth,  
by saying sorry when we have made a mistake,  
and by being proud to share our faith with others.*

*Parents can help children understand that being brave does not mean never being afraid. It means trusting that God is with us, even when we feel nervous or unsure.*

*This Gospel reminds us that we are deeply loved by God, and because of that love, we can face each day with confidence and hope.*

## Year 6 Confirmation

Our Year 6 pupils are now in their final week of preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation. They have shown great commitment and enthusiasm as they have deepened their understanding of their faith and reflected on the gifts of the Holy Spirit. We keep them in our prayers as they continue this important journey and look forward to celebrating this special milestone with them and their families.

If you have sold all your tickets and would like **additional books**, please contact **Mrs Edge**, who will be happy to send more home.

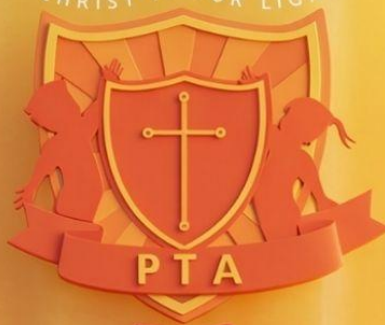
### Returning Tickets and Money
