Welcome to Reception!

It has been lovely to welcome your children into school. They all look so smart! They have impressed us with how well they have settled and are showing us that they are very much ready to learn! We are looking forward to getting to know your child and working with you in the year ahead.

This term, once our Baseline Assessments are completed, our first topic will be 'Oi, Frog!'. Other topics will include 'Patterns', 'Autumn' and 'Whatever Next'. In RE we will be learning about Creation, Baptism and Advent.

Prime Areas		
Personal and Emotional Development	Communication and Language	Physical Development
This is a key focus area for the first half term. We will be working on ensuring that the children feel happy and secure in the setting. We will explore the environment and meet the different adults who make up our school community. The children will be developing the confidence to speak to their peers and familiar adults and will be making new friends.	Initially, we will assess the children's language skills. We can then support where necessary. We will be encouraging the children to speak in sentences, share their news and ask for help. As well as listening and responding to ideas expressed by others, the children will also be encouraged to answer 'how' and 'why' questions about what we experience and learn through our topics.	We will begin to practise our fine motor skills, cutting, sticking, rolling and stretching. We do this by using Lego, play dough, threading, sand, marbles, building and model making materials. This will help us to hold a pencil and begin to use it to write letters and then words.

Other areas			
Literacy	Maths	Understanding the World	Expressive Arts and Design
This term starts our phonics sessions. The children will be introduced to four phonemes (sounds) during the week and will consolidate on Friday. We will learn how to write the phonemes as they are taught. We will do class reading as part of the session. The children will also have a reading book to share at home.	This term, we will begin to explore numbers. We will initially be focussing on sorting and patterns. We will then learn in depth all about numbers 1-5 and will focus on subitising and composition of number. We will also explore shapes.	We will be looking at the changing seasons and exploring Creation and our beautiful world. We will also explore 'Space' in our 'Whatever Next' topic.	We will be producing different artwork, exploring a variety of materials, tools and techniques. In music sessions, we will explore instruments and how they work and will learn new songs and rhymes.

Tapestry

Your child's learning journal will be on Tapestry. This will be used for observations and learning and also for updates and key information. It is a really useful tool. If you haven't already done so, please complete the permission slip. If you need any help using it, again please ask. We are more than happy to help. Feel free to upload anything from home for us to see. Maybe you are attending a family celebration, or your child gets a swimming certificate. Whatever it may be, we would love to see it! By doing this, we can celebrate their achievements at school too 😊

Reminders

- Please can you make sure that all uniform is **labelled with your child's name**.
- **Your child will need a book bag** that needs to be in school every day. This will be particularly helpful when we start sending books home soon. Our peg spaces are really small so large back packs are not ideal.
- Please can you send a labelled water bottle in each day.
- Black PE pumps, navy shorts and a school PE t-shirt will be needed every Tuesday. Please leave them in a bag on your child's peg.
- Please can you leave a pair of wellington boots in school and make sure that your child wears a coat appropriate for the weather.
- If you haven't already done so, please can you fill in the media consent form that has been emailed out as soon as possible.

Weekly Fund

We ask for a voluntary donation of £1 per week to help us to enhance our learning and provide your child with more experiences. This is completely voluntary and there is absolutely no obligation. A pot will be left outside the reception classroom during drop offs to leave your donation in, if you are able to. Over the last year, we have been able to replace broken toys and enhance our small world area and home corner in the classroom because of this.
