ON CALL (OC) PROCEDURE

PERSISTENT FAILURE TO MEET OUR EXPECTATIONS AND VALUES OR 'SERIOUS INCIDENT

Removed to Post 16 by TEACHER

Persistent Failure to meet our <u>Values and Expectations</u> (T1-3 has had no impact) or a Serious Incident will result in students being removed from the classroom and placed in a <u>POST 16 lesson</u>

Where it is not possible for teachers to take a student to Post 16 (Practical Lesson/Isolated Classroom, ON CALL can be used, but it will only be Removed to Post 16 by TEACHER)



OC 1 – Removed to Post 16 by ON CALL

Failure at Teacher level above will result in **ON CALL** being used. This leads to **a letter home**, and a **lockdown detention** the very next day.



OC 2 – Removed to MLT by ON CALL

Failure at OC1 will lead to an immediate **morning isolation**, **afterschool detention plus the OC 1 sanctions.**



OC 3 – Repeated Behaviours at level OC2

Three OC2 per half term – a warning letter is sent Four OC2 per half term – student placed onto 12-4 for **THREE DAYS**

On the rare occasion, that it is deemed unsafe for the student to be in lessons, students either will be <u>isolated all day</u> OR <u>sent home</u>. Sanctions will then be put in place for the following day, as described above.
