DMUaspire Summer School

The DMUaspire programme will take place on Monday 1 July to Friday 5 July for Year 12 (and equivalent) students. This is a five day non-residential summer school which gives students a complete university experience in a week of engaging activities.

DMUaspire will particularly benefit students who may just miss out on the academic grades to study at university or who have the capability of going into higher education but face social and/or economic barriers.

Upon successful completion of DMUaspire, students will be eligible for a reduction of 16 UCAS points towards an undergraduate degree at DMU.

Applications are now open and students will need to apply independently through our online application portal: https://www.dmu.ac.uk/study/dmuaspire/dmuaspire.aspx

We have 100 spaces available, however we do imagine it will be popular, so we encourage students to take their time filling in the personal statement section on their application.

DMUaspire is completely free of charge, lunch will be included and travel costs incurred via public transport can be reimbursed.
