The event takes place in the Charles Wilson Sports Hall, the University of Leicester on Weds 29th May from 10.30-15.30.

The Leicester Employability Day is a joint venture between the University of Leicester and the Foundation for Reach Society (FFRS) to address the educational and socio-economic under-attainment of youngsters of African, Caribbean and Dual Heritage. Leading organisations like Accenture, Caterpillar, Deloitte's, Grace Foods, Lloyds Bank, TSB, 3M, the College for High Speed Rail, and the Royal Institute of Chartered Surveyors, to name a few, will participate. Several prominent Leicestershire Black entrepreneurs and organisations will also participate.
