Eligible for free school meals.

Are a looked after child or care leaver.

Belong to a cultural or racial group under-represented in the City.

To apply students need to send an email to lesley.margiotta@prospects.co.uk stating in not more than 250 words why they feel they would benefit from a place on the Careers in Practice event, stating preferred event and dates, and how they fulfil the criteria specified.
