



Dear Parent/Carer,

Re: Continued Child Care Provision for Key Workers

We sent you a letter yesterday asking if you were on the key worker list that was provided by the Local Authority. The full detail of the government's proposal has been published and this Key Worker list is now the one required for use by schools. There are a number of areas of employment included, that were not included yesterday. The government has made it clear for parents to keep their children at home, wherever possible, and only send children into school when absolutely necessary. If you are in doubt ask your employer if you are on the critical key worker list. Another means of childcare would be a partner not on the key worker list or an adult sibling.

We have been asked to make clear that it is very important that we minimise the number of children in school. This is because we will be looking after the children of NHS workers. If their children become infected, then they cannot attend work. The more children we have, the more likely this is to happen. It is also more likely that your child may become infected and therefore you would have to self-isolate for 14 days. In order to minimise the chance of transmission, we are required to send children home immediately if they are displaying symptoms with the instruction that the whole household needs to self-isolate.

We have made provision for you to specify a limited number of days that you require this childcare. Headteachers have been asked to use their judgement should we have too many children needing

As I stated in my letter on Thursday evening, Bosworth Academy has made extensive plans for remote learning, through Show My Homework for KS3/4, and Google Classroom/email for Sixth Form. We want to reassure all parents that we will continue to support you in educating your child at home.
