Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Update following Government Announcement Mon 29th June

Following the announcement late Monday evening about stricter lockdown measures announced in Leicester because of a rise in coronavirus cases in specific parts of the city, I thought I should write to you to reassure you about our current provision in school.

As I am sure you are aware, Health Secretary Matt Hancock said non-essential shops will shut on Tuesday, and schools in the city will be asked to close their doors again to all but children of key-workers from Thursday.

The areas where schools are being closed, from Thursday, **do not** include Bosworth Academy, and this has been clarified by the Director for Children and Family Services for Leicestershire, Jane Moore.

Our provision will continue for our Year 10 and 12 face-to-face as it did previously. Our 'Supervised Childcare' provision for key-worker children and those identified for support will also go ahead.

We will contact parents of Year 7 about the tutor meetings planned later this week as to whether they can still proceed as we hoped or not.

From Thursday, we do not yet know if the guidance might restrict some children travelling from the city to us in Desford, Leicestershire. We will wait to see the detail in the government guidance that will be hopefully shared later today. If this situation changes then we will inform you immediately.
