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

WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW OR BE ABLE TO DO BEFORE TAKING THIS COURSE?

Grade 5 or above in an art and design subject at GCSE.

WHAT WILL I LEARN ON THIS COURSE?

The course starts with a skill building project, where you will try different techniques and skills, such as printing, embroidery and fabric manipulation. You will then choose a personal theme and develop this through research, drawing, sampling and designing, before creating a final outcome.

From February of year 13 you will complete an externally set project. You will be required to complete a final piece during a 15 hour controlled assessment.

Work could include fashion/accessories/interiors/textile art.

HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?
