YEAR 7: Introducing yourself!










 <p>Interview someone you know about their experience learning French. Can they teach you a word or something about the culture that you didn't know?</p>	 <p>Choose a theme (e.g. celebrities' names, animals, school subjects) and see if you can find an A-Z in French . Present using the method of your choice.</p>	 <p>Go around your house and find different numbers of objects (e.g. 2 socks, 5 pieces of spaghetti), take a picture of them and label the number in French.</p>
 <p>Produce a poster or Power-Point about the Norman Conquest and its influence on the English language.</p>	 <p>Teach a member of your family 10 French words that you have learnt so far.</p>	 <p>Find 5 French words used in everyday conversation in English and illustrate them.</p>
 <p>Create a revision Kahoot or Quizizz for what we have learnt during this topic (name,numbers,age, birthday).</p>	 <p>Choose 3-5 people who were important in the history of a French-speaking country. Create a wanted poster or factfile to give information about each.</p>	 <p>Research African countries and find out which of these speak French. Choose one to research in more detail.</p>
 <p>How quickly can you count to 30 in French? Record and time yourself, could you be the quickest in the class?!</p>	 <p>Create a short film of a French conversation using the questions that you have already learnt in French.</p>	 <p>Research a French celebrity and introduce them in French on a poster or in a video.</p>

YEAR 7: Family and Friends

 <p>Find a French version of a song you like on Youtube (one with lyrics included). Learn the lyrics and either sing to the class (in person/on video) or translate into English.</p>	 <p>Make a puzzle booklet (minimum 3 puzzles) relating to a topic you've covered in class. Remember to provide answers too!</p>	 <p>Find a sport which is only played in (or originates from) a French-speaking country. Organise a game and collect evidence of you playing!</p>
 <p>Describe yourself or someone you know using 3 words in French, draw these words in a creative way that represent the word.</p>	 <p>Take a picture of yourself or find a picture from Google and label the picture describing hair colour, length and style and eye colour</p>	 <p>Create a pic collage of a famous, cartoon or real family and label the family members in French.</p>
 <p>Explain which French football (or other sport) team you would support if you were living in France. Explain your choice by giving two reasons!</p>	 <p>The Great French Bake Off! Bake a dish for your family and friends that is inspired by France - take pictures and show your teacher!</p>	 <p>Interview a family member about their family growing up and write about it in French - you may learn something about your family that you didn't already know!</p>
 <p>Make a revision board game on the topic of family, friends and pets. Hand in with instructions for another class to try!</p>	 <p>Create a video introducing your pets in French! What are they called? What colour are they? How many do you have?</p>	 <p>Host a film night for your family or friends. Show a French film/ TV series and discuss it afterwards *Check age rating before showing*</p>

YEAR 7: My house

 <p>Design a crossword with clues in English describing rooms in a house and the answers in French, send to your teacher so that we can complete it in class!</p>	 <p>Create a comic-strip showing what you usually do in the evenings. Write the activities in French and draw creative pictures to go with it!</p>	 <p>Look at this <u>property website</u> to look at some houses for sale in France, which region looks appealing to you? Do houses look different to houses in the UK? Write a short report on what you have found.</p>
 <p>Describe a room in your house to a friend (what furniture is there? What colour is it?) and your friend must draw it. When done, compare it with the original, how accurate is the drawing?</p>	 <p>Talk to a friend or family member about the house they grew up in, draw it and label it in French.</p>	 <p>With a friend (via video chat?!) play French pictionary! Take it in turns to draw an activity you do in the evenings and the other must guess the word in French.</p>
 <p>Create a Youtube-style video tour of your house, introducing each of the rooms in French.</p>	 <p>Design a mood board for your dream bedroom, find pieces of furniture online, convert the price to euros and see what it would cost!</p>	 <p>Create a board game based on the topic of 'my house' - include instructions so that it can be played in class.</p>

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YEAR 7: School and Daily Life

 <p>Create a Youtube-style video tour of Bosworth Academy, introducing each of the rooms/facilities in French</p>	 <p>When you meet up with friends (or text/video call etc) always greet each other in French, make it 'the norm'!</p>	 <p>Become a teacher for the day! Teach someone at home how to talk about daily routines, film the result of your teaching.</p>
 <p>Explore the website of this French school, can you spot any similarities or differences with Bosworth? Write about it in English.</p>	 <p>Work with a partner to create a dialogue, asking and answering questions about school and daily life, record the conversation.</p>	 <p>Think about what your ideal school uniform would be... Draw it and label it in French, use this Quizlet vocab to help you.</p>
 <p>Create a comic-strip showing your daily routine. Write the routine in French and draw creative pictures to go with it!</p>	 <p>Create your Bosworth timetable in French! Make it creative by adding drawings/border art etc. Take a picture of it on your iPad and use it at school!</p>	 <p>Create a revision board game based on the topic of school - make sure that you include instructions so that we can play the game in class!</p>
