Research a traditional French dish, bake it and take a photo to send to your teacher as evidence!</p>
 <p>Revise how to form the passé composé past tense on BBC bitesize, take notes and test yourself with the quiz at the end.</p>	 <p>Create a French invite to an afternoon out, on paper or in digital form, to send to a friend. Give it to them and ask them to write a response!</p>	 <p>Create a personal profile for an imaginary social media platform, describe your appearance and personality in French using avoir and être.</p>
 <p>Quels sont les bienfaits et les inconvénients de Facebook?</p> <p>Have a debate with a friend!</p>	 <p>Research French music festivals, do they have an equivalent of Glastonbury?  <p>Create a mood board of what you want your future to look like! Write some French sentences in the future tense to go with it.</p>	 <p>Create a fact file on your favourite French sportsperson, do they play for a team? Where do they play? Have they won any leagues/trophies etc?</p>	 <p>Did you know that Serena Williams has taught herself French? Watch this short interview with Serena at the Roland Garros tournament.</p>
 <p>Create a kahoot revision quiz on the topic of 'bien dans sa peau' - include the vocabulary and grammar we have learnt.</p>	 <p>Revise the simple future tense on BBC bitesize, take notes and take yourself with the quiz at the end.</p>	 <p>Cook a healthy meal at home for yourself, friends or family, take a picture of it labelling the ingredients in the dish in French.</p>
 <p>Watch this video to learn some yoga phrases and expressions in French, could you then give your own French yoga tutorial?</p>	 <p>With your friends (maybe via video call!), play a game of French pictionary. Take it in turns to draw a sport/body part, the others must guess the item correctly in French.</p>	 <p>Create a youtube tutorial style video explaining to other students how to form the future tense.</p>
 <p>Watch this video of the song 'ramenez la coupe a la maison', released when France won the world cup in 2018, how many players' names can you hear in the song?</p>	 <p>Create an avatar using the body parts of different celebrities and label them in French, e.g. you could have the arms of the hulk and the legs of Jamie Vardy!</p>	 <p>Explore the Carrefour French supermarket website! Put together a healthy menu, find the ingredients and how much it would cost to make in euros.</p>

YEAR 8: A l'horizon

 <p>Create a job advertisement in French, on the advert write the name of the job, what kind of skills/attributes the person should have and what the job consists of.</p>	 <p>If you could travel to a place around the world to do some volunteer work. Write down: Where would you go and why. Do you speak their language?</p>	 <p>Les infos! Have a look at this news site, what is happening in the world? Try to translate one of the articles or write a summary of a video.</p>
 <p>Asking questions! Follow the link to remind yourself how to form questions in French, then create 3 questions that you could ask in a French job interview!</p>	 <p>Find someone who has been to a French-speaking country (Holiday? Lived there? Work?). Interview them about their experiences and come up with 5 best bits about the country.</p>	 <p>Let's work on pronunciation! Complete this mini BBC bitesize course on silent lessons in French and master your French accent.</p>
 <p>Make a poster explaining how languages connect the world and the opportunities that they provide. Perhaps ask Bosworth languages staff what learning languages has done for them?</p>	 <p>Create a job interview dialogue and film the job interview with a friend! Did they get the job?!</p>	 <p>Create a board game based on the topic 'a l'horizon' - remember to include instructions so that it can be played in class!</p>

 <p>Research a French festival which takes place in your birth month. Create a poster/leaflet/booklet to advertise it to the class.</p>	 <p>With your friends (maybe via video call!), play a game of French pictictionary. Take it in turns to draw an object you would pack in a suitcase, the others must guess the item correctly in French.</p>	 <p>Revise how to use and form <u>reflexive verbs</u> on BBC bitesize, make notes and then take the quiz at the end to test yourself!</p>
 <p>Use travel websites to plan a trip around a French speaking country (or several countries!) Create a brochure advertising the holiday. Where will you go? How much will it cost? And what should you pack?</p>	 <p>Draw or make a detailed map of a country where they speak French. Include regions/ counties, at least 10 major cities and rivers, and other interesting features.</p>	 <p>Create a Kahoot revision quiz on the topic of 'Spécial vacances', including both vocab and grammar questions!</p>
 <p>Read this article about the best places to visit in France, which ones would you like to visit in the future?</p>	 <p>Research French music and create yourself a French holiday playlist to share with the class! Who is your favourite French artist?</p>	 <p>Write a holiday diary in French, use 3 tenses to talk about where you went last year, normally go and would like to go. (Remember it doesn't have to be true!)</p>
