

## KS3 LANGUAGES SUPER CURRICULUM YEAR 8: Ma vie sociale d'ado



Interview someone you know about their experience learning French. Can they teach you a word or something about the culture that you didn't know?



Revise how to form the near future tense on BBC bitesize, take notes and test yourself with the quiz at the end

Research a traditional French dish, bake it and take a photo to send to your teacher as evidence!



Revise how to form the passé composé past tense on BBC bitesize, take notes and test yourself with the quiz at the end.



Create a French invite to an afternoon out, on paper or in digital form, to send to a friend. Give it to them and ask them to write a response!



Create a personal profile for an imaginary social media platform, describe your appearance and personality in French using avoir and être.

Have a debate with a friend!



Research French music festivals, do they have an equivalent of Glastonbury? Create a presentation to share with the class about which one you would like to attend.



Revise how to form the present tense on BBC bitesize, take notes and test yourself with the quiz at the end.



Research African countries and find out which of these speak French. Choose one to research in more detail.



Create a short film of a French conversation using the questions that you have already learnt in French.



Create a Kahoot revision quiz on the topic of 'ma vie sociale d'ado', including both vocab and grammar questions!

Create a mood board of what you want your future to look like! Write some French sentences in the future tense to go with it.



Create a fact file on your favourite French sportsperson, do they play for a team? Where do they play? Have they won any leagues/trophies etc?

Create a kahoot revision quiz on the topic of 'biens dans sa peau' - include the vocabulary and grammar we have learnt.



Revise the simple future tense on BBC bitesize, take notes and take yourself with the quiz at the end.



Cook a healthy meal at home for yourself, friends or family, take a picture of it labelling the ingredients in the dish in French.



Watch this video to learn some yoga phrases and expressions in French, could you then give your own French yoga tutorial?



With your friends (maybe via video call!), play a game of French pictionary. Take it in turns to draw a sport/body part, the others must guess the item correctly in French.



Create a youtube tutorial style video explaining to other students how to form the future tense.



Watch this video of the song 'ramenez la coupe a la maison', released when France won the world cup in 2018, how many players' names can you hear in the song?



Create an avatar using the body parts of different celebrities and label them in French, e.g. you could have the arms of the hulk and the legs of Jamie Vardy!

Create a job advertisement in French, on the advert write the name of the job, what kind of skills/attributes the person should have and what the job consists of.



If you could travel to a place around the world to do some volunteer work. Write down: Where would you go and why. Do you speak their language?

Have a look at this news site, what is happening in the world? Try to translate one of the articles or write a summary of a video.



Asking questions! Follow the link to remind yourself how to form questions in French, then create 3 questions that you could ask in a French job interview!



Find someone who has been to a French-speaking country (Holiday? Lived there? Work?). Interview them about their experiences and come up with 5 best bits about the country.



Let's work on pronunciation! Complete this mini <u>BBC bitesize</u> course on silent lessons in French and master your French accent.



Make a poster explaining how languages connect the world and the opportunities that they provide. Perhaps ask Bosworth languages staff what learning languages has done for them?



Create a job interview dialogue and film the job interview with a friend!
Did they get the job?!



Create a board game based on the topic 'a l'horizon' - remember to include instructions so that it can be played in class!

## KS3 LANGUAGES SUPER CURRICULUM YEAR 8: Spécial vacances



Research a French festival which takes place in your birth month. Create a poster/leaflet/booklet to advertise it to the class.



With your friends (maybe via video call!), play a game of French pictionary. Take it in turns to draw an object you would pack in a suitcase, the others must guess the item correctly in French.



Revise how to use and form reflexive verbs on BBC bitesize, make notes and then take the quiz at the end to test yourself!



Use travel websites to plan a trip around a French speaking country (or several countries!)
Create a brochure advertising the holiday. Where will you go? How much will it cost? And what should you pack?



Draw or make a detailed map of a country where they speak French.
Include regions/ counties, at least 10 major cities and rivers, and other interesting features.



Create a Kahoot revision quiz on the topic of 'Spécial vacances', including both vocab and grammar questions!



Read this article about the best places to visit in France, which ones would you like to visit in the future?



Research French music and create yourself a French holiday playlist to share with the class! Who is your favourite French artist?



Write a holiday diary in French, use 3 tenses to talk about where you went last year, normally go and would like to go.
(Remember it doesn't have to be true!)
