

# Year 8 Enslaved African Trade Super Curriculum

## Statues of Slavers

**Critical Thinking** - Research the issues around statues of British people involved in Slavery and come to a judgement as to whether you think they should be allowed to remaining standing or need more information with them.



**Watch 'Enslaved', a documentary on slavery to learn more about this period of history.**

**Character** - Being motivated to learn more.



Includes graphic descriptions of the past that some students may find upsetting.

**Take a virtual tour around a slavery museum.**

**Citizenship** - What was it like to live in West Africa? What were the cultural achievements of the Igbo?



## The roles of different people in the Slave Trade

**Collaboration** - work with someone else to further explore the different roles people played during the slave trade.



**Design your own West African Kingdom artwork.**



**Creativity** - Study the culture of African Kingdoms and design your own artwork in the style of West African Kingdoms.
