I will meet many of you in Year 11, when you are starting to apply for colleges and

apprenticeships. But students from other year groups may need help too. If you are in Year 12 or 13, you can always ask your tutor or Head of Year for a referral to us and I will make an appointment to see you.

I am looking forward to meeting many of you over the coming months. Previously, I was a teacher at Secondary and Primary schools. I also have children who have applied for colleges and University, so I can appreciate how stressful it can sometimes feel when you are trying to make the right decision.

What Career Advice Would I Give to Students? Whatever you do, start early! Year 11 or 13 are already busy years, so don't leave everything to the last minute. It is never too early to start researching ideas and talk to people, family and friends about possible ideas of what you might want to do in the future. There are also wonderful tools out there, like a career quiz if you really don't have any ideas. Your tutor will show you where you can find this. And finally, always make sure you have a back-up! Sometimes, things don't always go exactly as planned and it's sensible to consider and apply for alternatives choices, just in case.

Caterpillar Placement

Over the last two years, lots of our Real LiFE Curriculum students have achieved amazing things through their personal enrichment goals they have set themselves during Crew time.



A recent example of this was a group of students in 8GWR who are currently working with engineers at Caterpillar to create a physical version of a reaction game that they developed during CREW. Some of the students designed a reaction board as part of their work for the 10X Challenge which is a National Enterprise competition. The students earned how to use a computer program to do this and their prototype could be operated on an interactive whiteboard.

During the 10X Challenge week they were given a couple of opportunities to advertise their game as part of a selling event in which other students could pay to use the game. They made a net profit of \pounds 39.35 from this.

They are now working with Caterpillar to produce a stand alone prototype that can be used at school events and maybe in areas of the school all the time.

Congratulations to all students involved, for such an achievement!

across three campuses in Coalville, Melton Mowbray and Brooksby. We thank SMB College for the visit and an informative discussion.


