Safeguarding children is our highest moral imperative. If not you, who? If not now, when?

-Bruises or marks -Tender limbs -Fear of adults -Anti-social -Unusual issues at school

Physical

-Depression -Hostility/stress -Eating disorders -Apathy -Distant from parents

Emotional

-Inappropriate interest/ knowledge of sexual acts -Unstable moods -Change in appearance

Sexual

-Poor clothing -Hungry -Dirty -Poor supervision -Tiredness -Poor growth

Neglect

If a child makes a disclosure:

- Reassure them
- Don't promise confidentiality
- Don't ask leading questions
- Listen, note, date
- Pass to DSL or deputy via email or directly if it is urgent (dsl@bosworthacademy.org.uk)

Staff have a legal duty to report instances of Female Genital Mutilation (FGM) to the police.

If you have concerns about a member of staff, you must tell the Headteacher. If you have concerns about the Headteacher, you must tell the Chair of Governors-Emma Hollis Brown. Those people will then contact Authority the Local Designated Officer (LADO). Further details on our website.

Indications of Child Criminal or Sexual Exploitation (CCE or CSE)

- Unexplained money
- New friendship groups
- Poor personal hygiene
- New clothes, hairstyles etc...
- Unusually tired
