Booking for Parents Evening

Dear Parents/Carers,

For years 9-13, we will be using the schoolcloud system, which enables parents to meet with teachers remotely via video call. Please remember that tutors and teachers can be contacted at any time throughout the year to discuss any issues or for an update on progress.

To increase capacity this year, parents will have the opportunity to book with <u>either</u> of their child's subject teachers (where they are taught by more than one person). Both teachers will be able to report on the child's progress and parents should select only one subject teacher when booking.
