Art, Craft and Design	A Level	Grade 5 in an Art and Design subject at GCSE (*not including Hospitality and Catering).
Biology	A/AS Level	Students studying GCSE Combined Science need to have achieved a minimum Grade 6-6. Students studying GCSE Separate Sciences need at least two Grade 6s and a Grade 5 (with one of the 6s being in Biology).  Students also need to have achieved a Grade 6 in Maths.
Business Studies	A/AS Level	Grade 5 in GCSE Business if subject taken.
Chemistry	A/AS Level	Students studying GCSE Combined Science need to have achieved a minimum Grade 6-6. Students studying GCSE separate Sciences need at least two Grade 6s and a Grade 5 (with one of the 6s being in Chemistry).
Computer Science	A Level	Grade 6 in GCSE Computer Science and Grade 6 in Maths.
Core Maths	AS Level	Grade 5 in GCSE Maths at Foundation or Higher Tier.
Dance	A/AS Level	Grade 5 in GCSE Dance or equivalent vocational dance qualification.
Engineering	Level 3	Grade 5 in GCSE Maths and Science.
English Language	A Level	Grade 5 GCSE English Literature and English.
English Literature	A Level	Grade 6 in GCSE English Literature.
Extended Project	AS Level	No additional qualifications required.
Film Studies	A Level	Grade 5 in English Literature.
Food Science & Nutrition	Level 3	Grade 5 in one Science subject. If you have studied Hospitality and Catering then a Level 2 Merit or above is required, or Level 5 in Food Preparation and Nutrition. Previous study of a food subject not essential but a portfolio of work needs to be seen.
French	A/AS Level	Grade 6 or above in French.
Geography	A Level	Must gain a Grade 5 in Geography if studied, Grade 5 or above in GCSE English Literature.
History	A Level	Grade 5 or above in History/Geography.
Maths	A/AS Level	Grade 6 or above in GCSE Maths.
Further Maths	A/AS Level	Grade 7 in GCSE Maths and choosing Maths at A level.
Media Studies	A Level	Grade 5 in Media if studied and Grade 5 English Literature.
Music (Performance)	RSL Level 3	Good musical experience on an instrument/voice and to be able to perform pieces of music that are of Grade 5 standard. You will need to perform a song/piece for your audition to be accepted onto the course.
Photography	A Level	Grade 5 in an Art & Design subject at GCSE (*not including Hospitality and Catering) or, if not studied, must have a portfolio of photographs.
Physical Education	A/AS Level	Grade 5 in GCSE Physical Education which must include a Grade 5 on the written paper. If GCSE Physical Education is not taken then a Grade 5 in Science. Students must be playing competitive sport regularly outside of school.
Physics	A/AS Level	Students studying GCSE Combined Science need to have achieved a minimum Grade 6-6.  Students studying GCSE separate sciences need at least two grade 6s and a grade 5 (with one of the 6s being in Physics). Students also need to have achieved a Grade 6 in Maths.
Psychology	A/AS Level	Grade 5 in GCSE Science.
Sociology	A/AS Level	Grade 5 in English Literature.
Textiles	A Level	Grade 5 in an Art & Design subject at GCSE.
Theatre Studies	A Level	Grade 5 in English Literature.
