Our Response to the survey results:

We are so pleased with positive results from this survey, especially linked to the teaching, progress and encouragement. It is great to hear that parents feel they can approach school and are welcomed into the building. Our behaviour is something we take great pride in and are constantly looking for ways to improve this, both inside and outside of the building.

In response to the comments where a high negative response was given:

My child receives an appropriate amount of homework for his/her age - In September we will be reviewing the homework taking into account that we have changed our two online homework providers which has naturally caused some teething problems. We know that some Parents feel that their child gets too much homework whilst others feel they do not get enough, but we will try to come to a happy middle ground.

My child enjoys a stimulating range of extra-curricular activities - This year has seen many new clubs being introduced, some which have been popular and others not. We are aware that many clubs we hold, have required the use of the hall which limits our choices and times. So, next year we are researching new club providers and will try to ensure all year groups are able to access clubs after school.

My child is encouraged to lead a healthy lifestyle - This year our 'healthy living week' was such a success with so many families enjoying the bike ride and the 'wake up and shake up.' We are looking into options to make this a more regular feature and will let you know as soon as plans have been finalised.

- More clubs
- More notice for dates

Next steps we are acting on because of the Survey:

- We will be reorganising our clubs so that all children are able to access a variety of activities which we hope they will enjoy.
- Dates are now on the website and this will be constantly updated to allow for parents to make the relevant arrangements. All staff are aware of the changes in dates that have caused an issue this year and will endeavour to avoid this in the next academic year.
- The homework policy is to be reviewed and firm consistent approaches to be in place from next term so that the children are all benefitting from the homework that has been set.
- Meetings have already taken place between the new teachers and new documentation has been put in place to ensure that information sharing is as good as it can possibly be.
