The School Garden Project is well underway thanks to the funding received from AkzoNobel. After a huge tidy-up operation we are now in the process of buying a greenhouse, seating, picnic tables, raised beds and a fire pit. This will make great use of our outdoor space and further enhance the children's learning experience. Many thanks to Mrs Carr and Mrs McCann for leading the project, and to all of the families, children, staff and Akzo Nobel employees who gave up their time to help us.

The children in year 6 are working with Claire Ford from We EngAge to develop their digital literacy skills and to share these with people in the community. Over the next few weeks they will work with residents from The Grange to make e-books based on their knowledge and learning about WW2.

This project has been funded by The Cultural Spring.

Thank you for your generous contributions towards the harvest appeal. We collected a huge amount of tins and foodstuffs for the New Hope Church which supports people in need. The Poppy Appeal has been very successful and 69 boxes were collected for Operation Christmas Child. Children also donated a large bag of sweets for the Operation Christmas Child 'sweet mountain.'

# <u>PTA</u>


