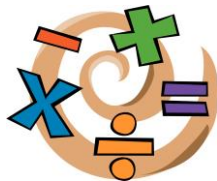
### School Meals

#### **After School Provision and Clubs**

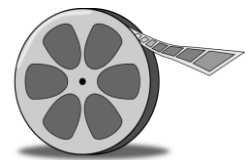
