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Changes

Last year, Mr Shenton asked parents what they want from our school. The results showed that parents desire bullying being tackled, better communication, improved homework and better information about progress.

To tackle these concerns the school has made positive strides. Here is an outline of the steps that we have taken:

1) Communication

The school has increased the regularity of newsletters and is delighted

Additionally, we introduced termly parent events for families to come into school to work alongside their children. We hope you have enjoyed them as much as the pupils have.

2) Bullying

The school staff and governors have developed its Behaviour and Discipline Policy. We have formalised the praise and Dojo points systems and pupils will receive rewards this term in line with the policy. The school has also taken steps to improve the effectiveness of the Reflection Room and the way it records incidents and actions.

3) Homework

In September, we launched a new homework system. The feedback that we have received has been very encouraging!

4) Progress

We have had two parents' evenings so far this school year and the feedback has been mixed. Some parents have informed the school that the conversations about standards were clear and welcomed the changes. Others have let us know that they were unsure and asked for another meeting for clarification. To tackle this in the future, the school will provide a summary page for parents with achievements, targets and the latest assessment results.

Swimming


Class 8 have completed their swimming and have made fantastic progress during their sessions at
