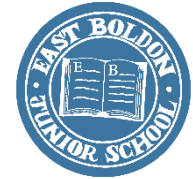

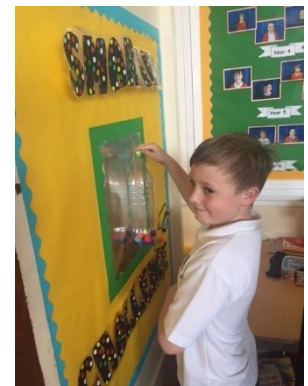


We are challenging the whole school to make an eco-brick at home. An eco-brick is a plastic bottle packed with non-recyclable plastic. These are then used to build.
