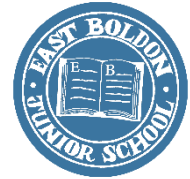

### Roman Day in Year 3

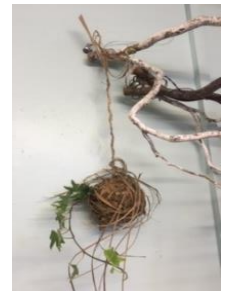
