Science

To continue our topic 'what lives in our playground.'

Can you create a non chronological report about a ladybird or a butterfly? Remember to include what they eat, Where they live, How they sleep etc

PSHE

Ask children to consider what's important to them (example: being happy; being good at drawing; having lots of friends; having a tidy room; eating nice food at lunch).

Fill out the 'Project Happiness' worksheet (attached at the bottom) with those pieces that make them happy!

Discuss why different emotions are useful. At the end of the clip, Joy - the narrator - wasn't sure why Sadness was useful. Ask the children what they think.

Now watch the 'Sadness saves Riley' clip (contains 'Inside Out' spoilers)

Discuss how all emotions serve a purpose and these lead us to behave in different ways.

However, we have a choice as to the action we take given how we feel.

On the back of your project happiness worksheet , answer the following questions:

Why are different emotions useful? What makes you happy? What could you do to make this more likely?






