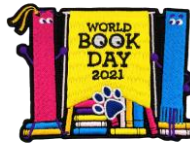
### Reopening

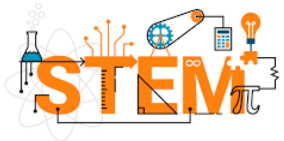
This week, Mrs Burns created our first Reading for Pleasure Newsletter which is available on our website:

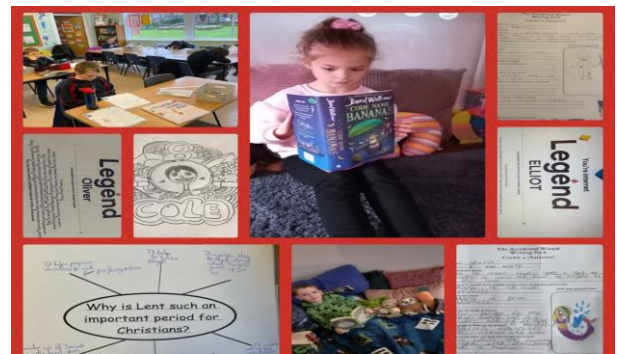
**Stay safe**
