


Reading for Pleasure: Newsletter #2




Welcome to East Boldon Juniors' second Reading for Pleasure newsletter. I hope you find enjoyment and inspiration!

He gets a lot more than he bargained for when he plays a prank on the homeless man living in the park and is embroiled in an *unbelievable mystery*. Remember that reading for pleasure is not just about reading traditional books so this half term year 6 have helped me recommend some great graphic novels.


The Witches Graphic Novel- Roald Dahl. A bright and colourful treatment of the classic book.

The 13-Storey Treehouse- Andy Griffiths. An imaginative and exciting story full of hilarity and wackiness!




Reading for Pleasure at School

We are desperately trying to improve the selection of reading material that we have available in school.


We have already invested in some new books for teaching from and for our reading areas in our classes but we'd love more!
