Staff have been busy in school during the summer, getting the place ready for the children tomorrow. Here are a few questions and answers to help with returning to school tomorrow.



Q: Will my child be placed in a bubble this term?

A: Latest guidance has removed the need for bubbles in school. However, we will use common sense and not encourage mixing unnecessarily.

Q: What if someone in my child's class tests positive?

A: On most occasions, children will continue to attend school unless they develop COVID symptoms.

Q: Which gate does my child use?

A: There are no restrictions to which you use for our risk assessments but the Y3 pupils closest gate is the one on the playground; Y4/5SC the park gate and 5JM/Y6 the main drive gate.

Q: What is school doing to be as safe as possible?

A: Good hygiene practices, continued cleaning regimes, ventilated spaces.

Q: What does my child need for school?

A: Just the normal stuff: coat, bag, inhaler, packed lunch (unless your child has a school dinner). We provide pens, pencils etc.

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Q: When is my child's PE day and what do they need?

A: Your child's class teacher will tell you your PE day. On your child's PE day, they can dress in PE kit for the full day.



Q: Do we need face masks?

A: The DfE has stated that face masks 'are no longer advised for pupils, staff and visitors'. However we would still prefer visitors to wear a mask for everyone's safety if possible. Thank you

Q: What will homework look like?

A: Last year for safety reasons, we didn't send homework books home. We are this year. Teachers have created homework challenges in grids. There is a letter in the homework books explaining how they work.

Q: What time does school start and finish?

A: We ring the bell at 8:50 to let you know that we are opening the doors. We will ring it again at 8:55 to announce that school is starting and doors will close.

Q: Can I send in a snack for playtime?

A: Yes. We are very happy for your child to have a healthy snack. We have a bin on the playground for rubbish. Some children have allergies so no items that contain nuts. Thank you
