



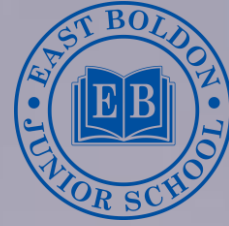

**great** time!

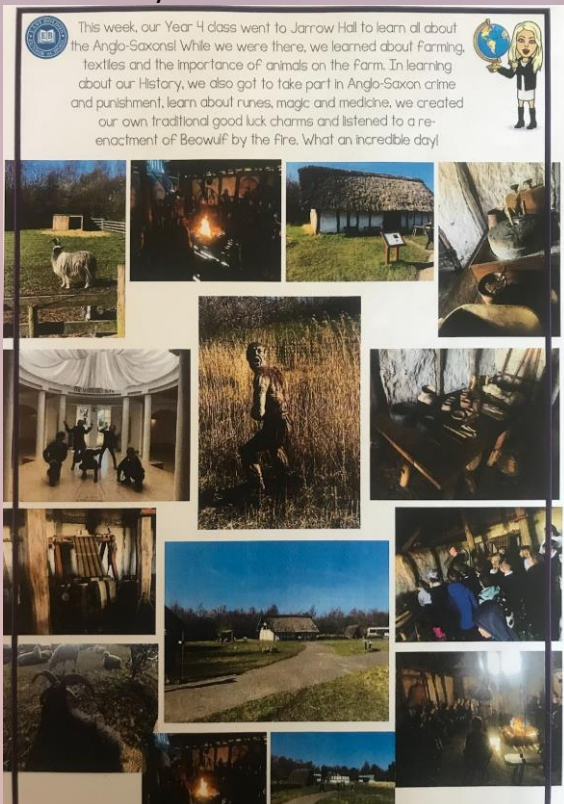


## Jarrow Hall Trip
