



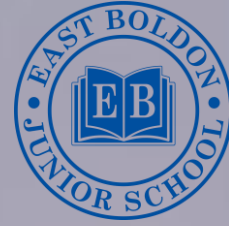

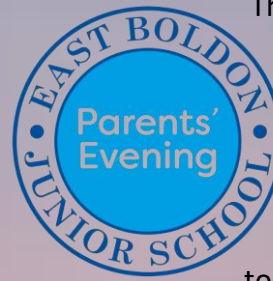
Harvest Festival
