## **Continued Caution**

As we move through March, we are also mindful that this is the start of the end of Lockdown for the whole country. Thank you for your cooperation in keeping to the safety measures put in place to minimise the spread of the virus and keep all our classes open. As a reminder:

- Adults to wear face coverings when dropping off and picking up children
- Keep 2 metres apart from other people
- Make use of the staggered start and finish time to reduce the numbers of pedestrians on Swansbrook Lane and School Lane
- Do not send your child into school if they are unwell (this keeps other bugs spreading within the school)
- If your child shows any of the 3 main symptoms of Covid -19 ( temperature, new continuous cough or loss of smell or taste), you must book a test and keep your child off school until the results come back
- A positive test result for your child means self- isolation for 10 days from when the symptoms began
- A positive test result needs to be reported to school as soon as possible so we can alert the relevant authorities and organise the closure of the relevant bubble in school
