Phonics	<p>Phonics is taught daily using the using RWI. Reading books are matched to the RWI phonics scheme.</p> <p>EYFS RWI phonics daily lessons. Reading book bag to go home</p> <p>KS1 RWI phonics RWI home book bag RWI Spelling Y2</p>
Reading	<p>At Forest View we continually promote the love of reading. We use a variety of different ways to achieve this from modelling teacher reading, to inviting reading corners, to sending children home with scheme books, to class books, to specific interventions with children.</p> <p>In addition to the love of reading, we also focus on the pace and fluency of reading. This is taught through phonics and key intervention alongside the daily reading lessons and in KS2 through the use of Reading Plus.</p> <p>Reading skills are taught through either group guided reading sessions or whole class teaching. The following reading domains are covered and the children should have had exposure to the teaching of each of these content domains at an age appropriate level linked to a challenging, age appropriate book. The content domains are listed below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fluency• Word Meaning - draw on knowledge of vocabulary to understand texts• Retrieval - identify/explain key aspects of fiction and non-fiction texts, such as characters, events, titles and information• Sequencing - identify and explain the sequence of events in texts• Inference - make inferences from the text/explain and justify inferences with evidence from the text• Prediction - predict what might happen from details stated and implied <p>Texts are carefully chosen as a stimulus for learning, they will drive the theme and therefore link to many different subject areas. The key texts are chosen and will also drive the writing for each theme. Alternative and complimentary texts/extracts will also be chosen by teachers to allow them to create comparisons between texts, looking for both similarities and differences and experience a range of genres.</p> <p>EYFS: RWI individual home/school reading book bag.</p> <p>KS1: RWI individual home/school book bag.</p> <p>KS2: Accelerated Reading Scheme home/school reading books. Y4 - Y6 Reading Plus programme delivered 3 times weekly</p>



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	<p>Whole School: Daily dedicated time to the enjoyment and continual love of reading supplements our more focused sessions. Activities include: The class teacher reading a quality text to the children The children having access to topic related books Reading Plus</p>
Whole Class Guided Reading	<p>Y2 - Y6 Forest View follow the WCGR approach to guided reading, as well as using varied, balanced, age-appropriate texts. These provide an enriched curriculum. Those children in need of additional support also receive additional small group sessions.</p>
