Every time the bin is full, it will be emptied and school will be given an amount of money which is determined by the weight of the items donated. What can you put in the bin?

Well-loved children's and adult's clothes, shoes, bags and accessories. These need to be put in a sealed bag before they are placed in the bin.

What cannot be put in the bin?

Damaged clothing, bedding, curtains and bric-a-brac.

You can also have items collected from your home for free and the money will still be received by school. This is especially useful during the school holidays when the bin is not accessible.
