

SEND- Parent's/ Carers voice- 2022/23

22 Parents/ Carers responded:

- 86% felt their child was safe and happy at school.
- 86% felt their child had someone to talk to if they needed to.
- 91% could see the progress their child was making in school.
- 96% said they knew how their child was supported within school.
- 91% felt they had sufficient information and communication about their child's progress.
- 100% felt they were able to approach staff regarding any concerns they have about their child.
- 95% thought issues or concerns raised about their child's needs were addressed quickly.
- 77% thought the website had useful information about SEND.
- 68% knew where to find the SEND policy and impact report and thought these were clear.
- 86% have confidence in the leadership of SEND provision within school.

Some comments made by parents/carers:
