IF I WERE PRIME MINISTER

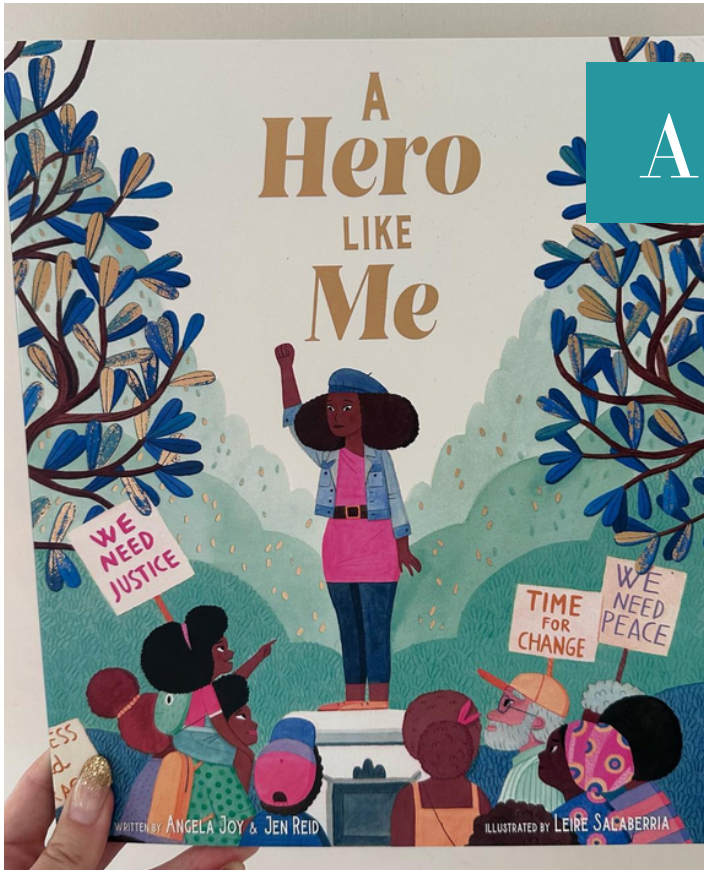

Empowering children to have courage to stand up for what is right and being their own hero.



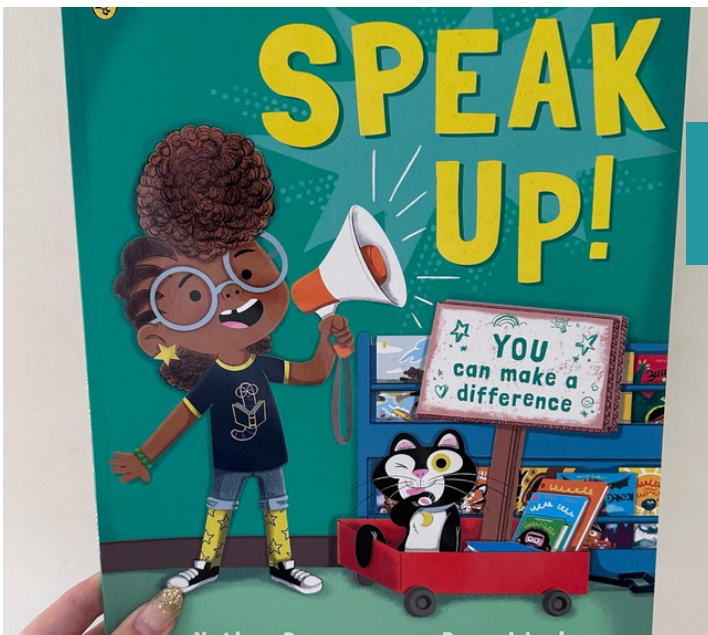
SOFIA VALDEZ FUTURE PREZ

Sofia Valdez is told that she can't make a difference as she is only a child! She vows to prove them wrong. 'It all starts with one person to make a change.'



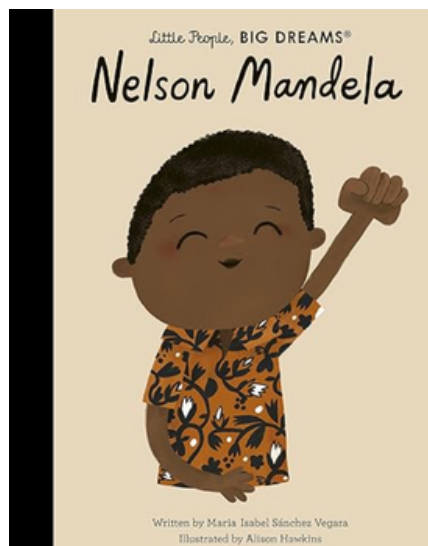
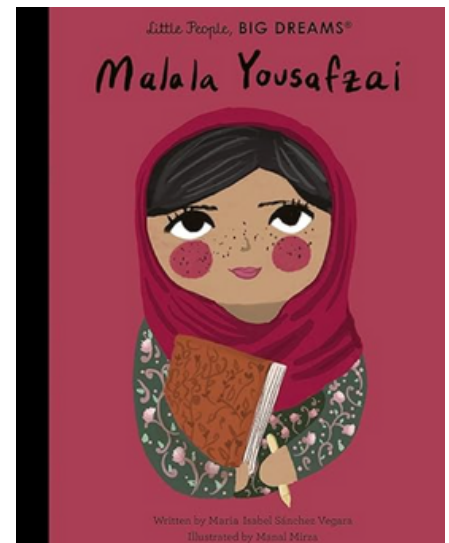
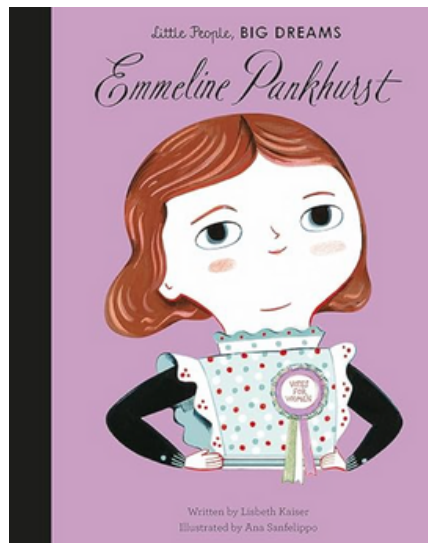
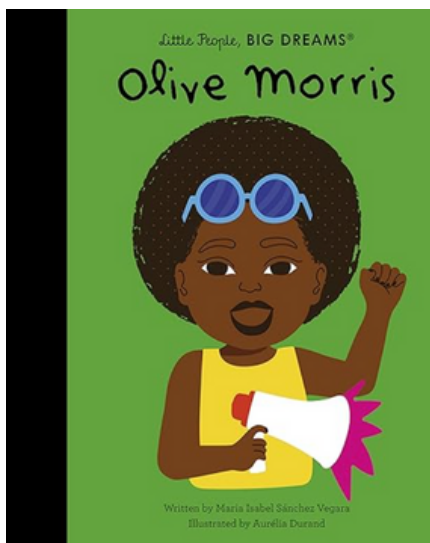
SPEAK UP!
