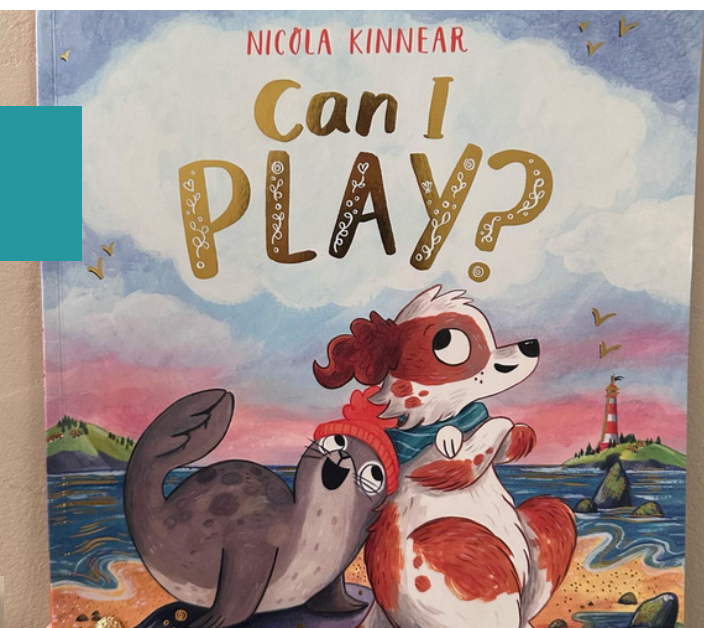


## FINN'S LITTLE FIBS

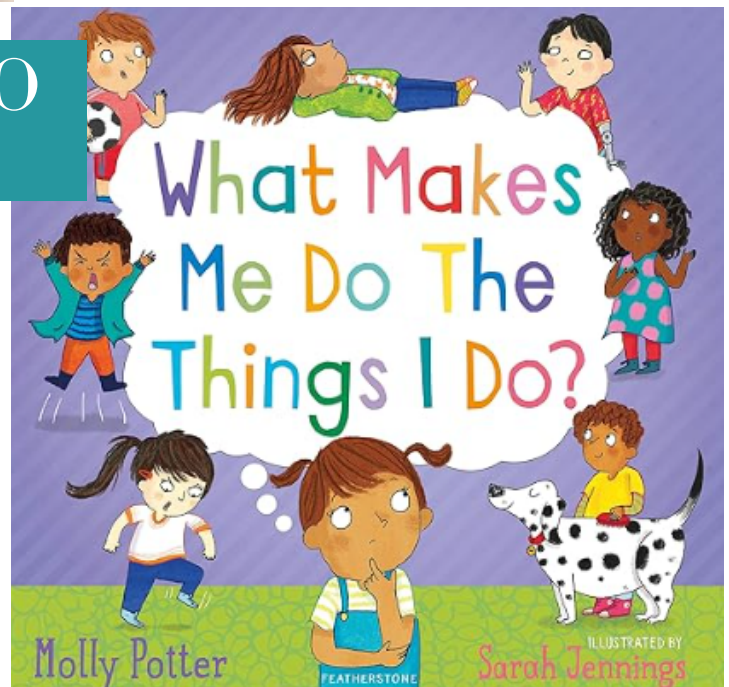
# KINDNESS GROWS

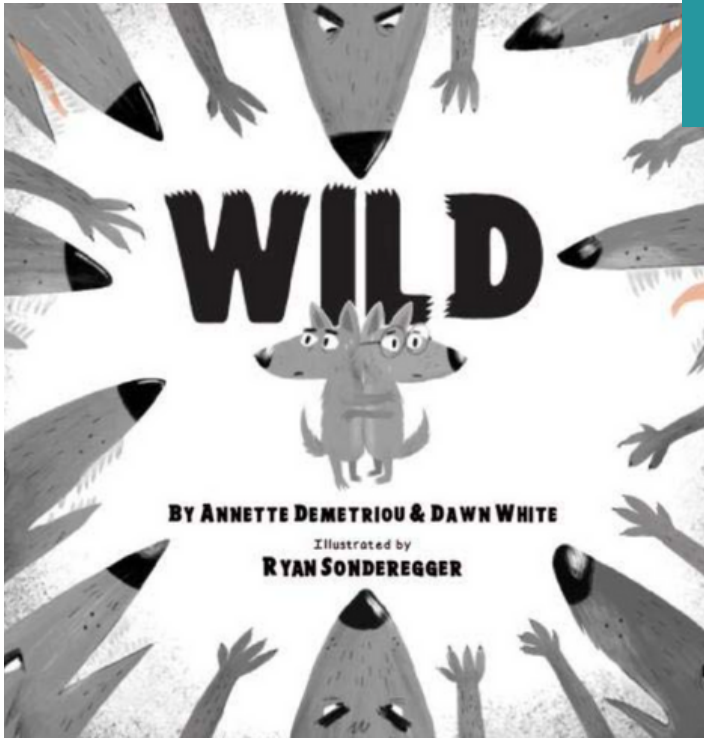
# THE QUEEN NEXT DOOR

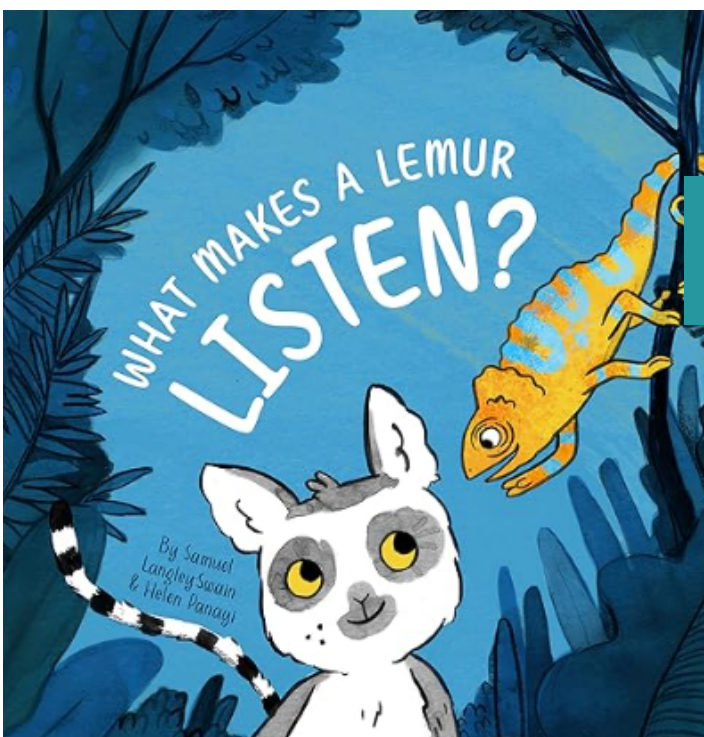
# WHAT WESLEY WORE

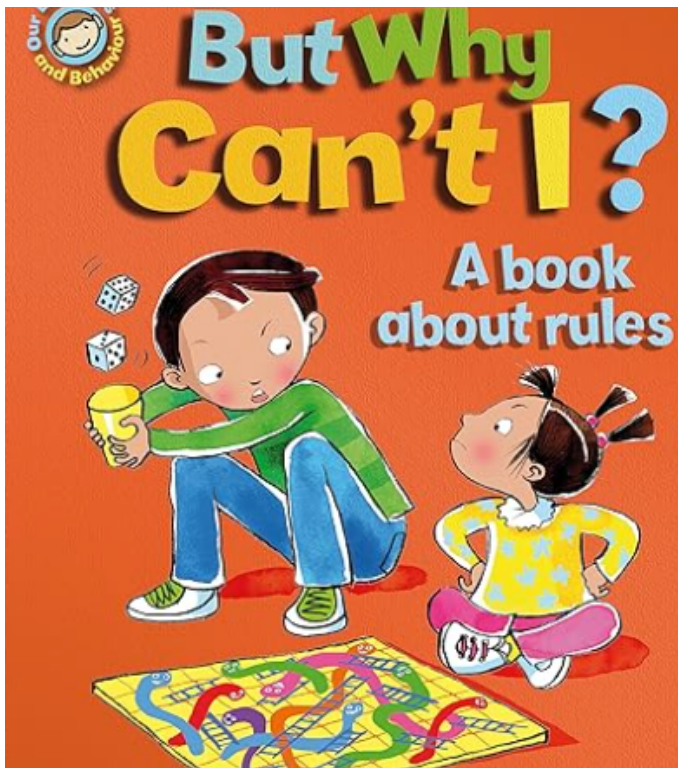
Wesley is bullied for being different and moves away after feeling rejected. The other weasels recognise their mistake and apologise to Wesley.

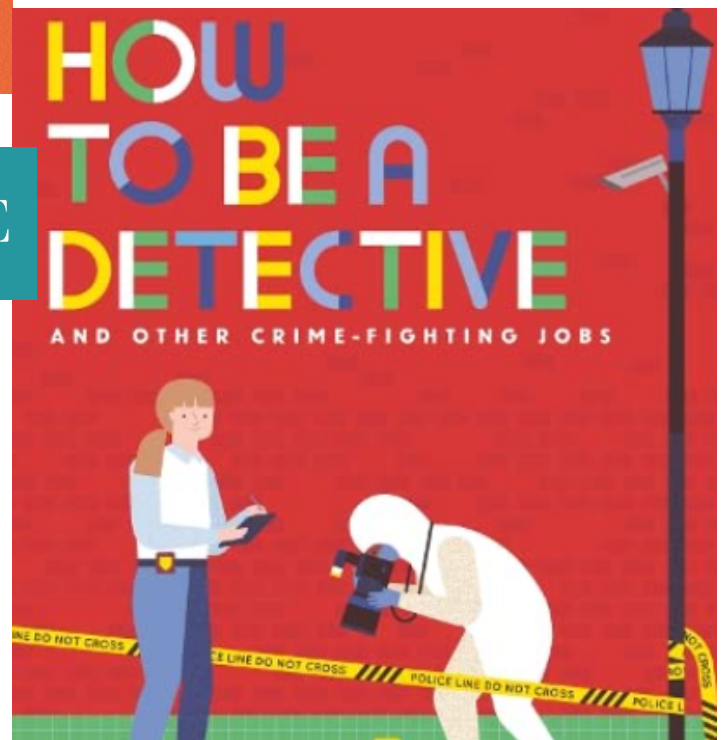


## BUT WHY CAN'T I?

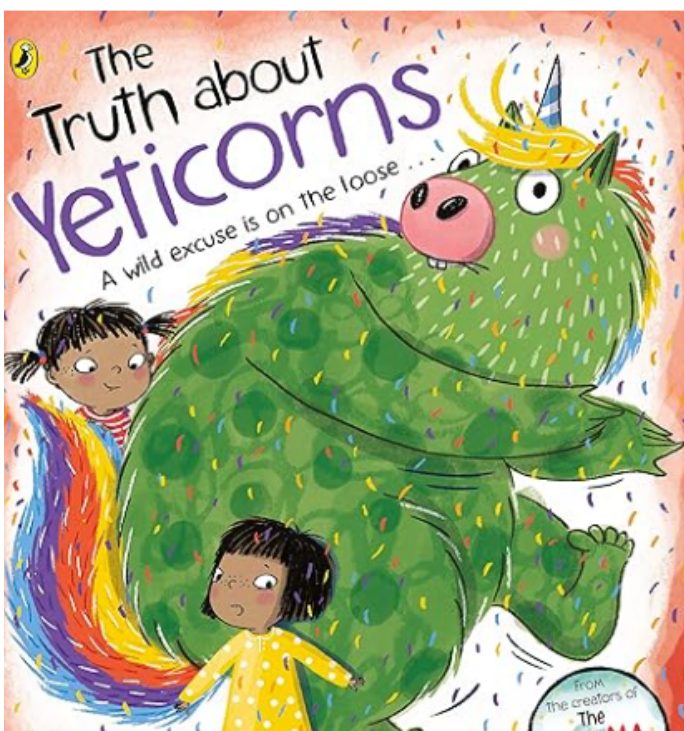
## HOW TO BE A DETECTIVE

## RACE CARS

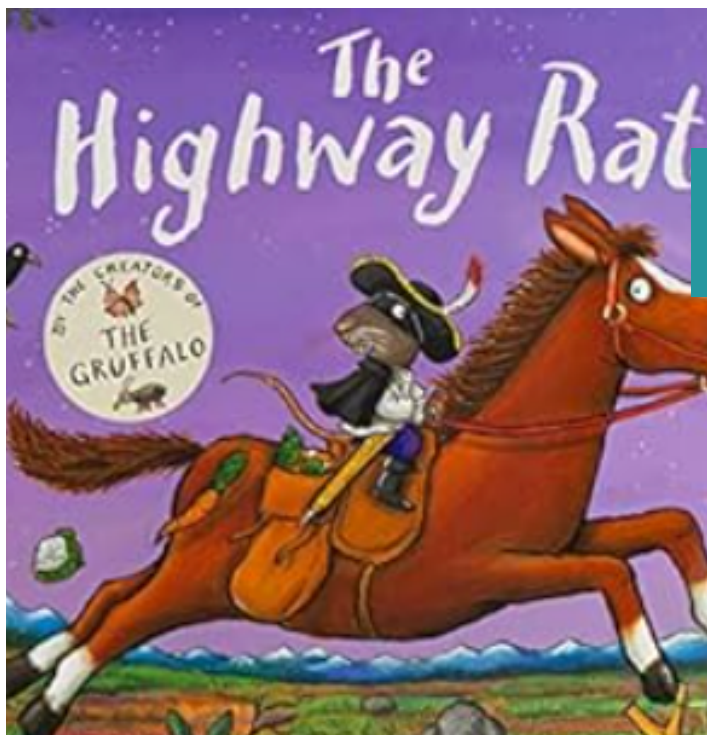
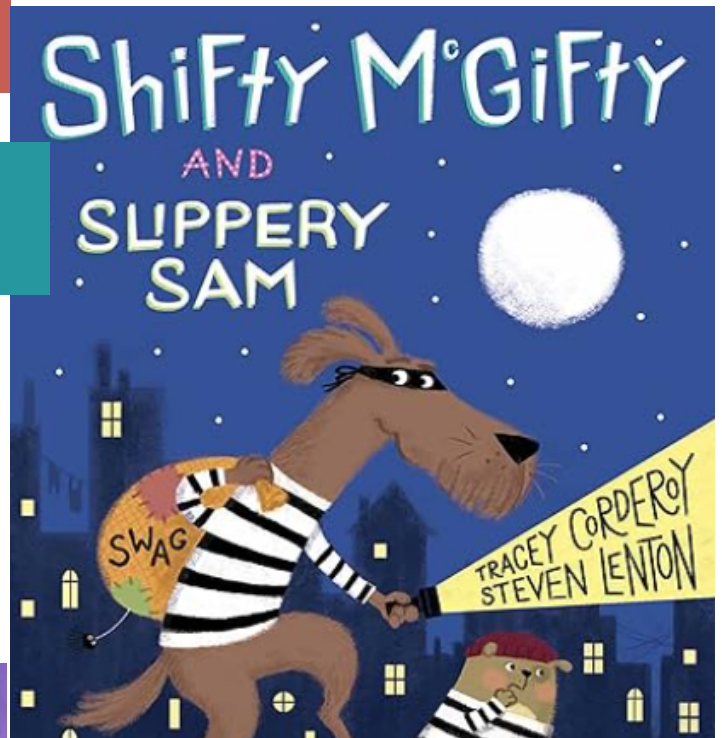

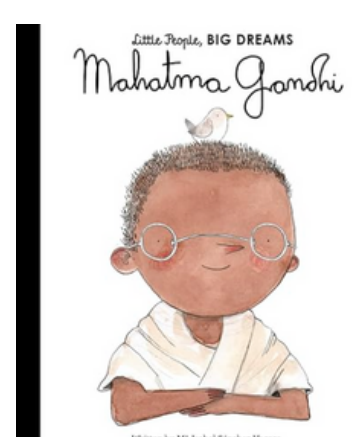
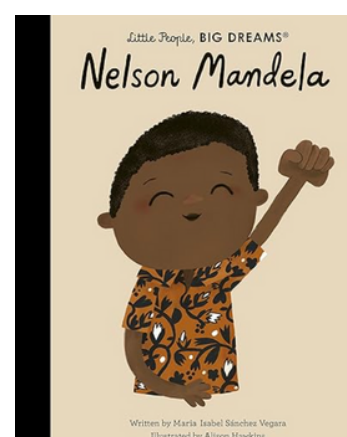
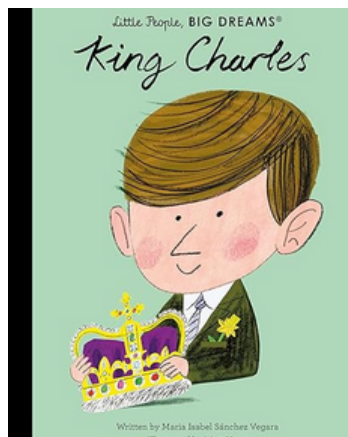
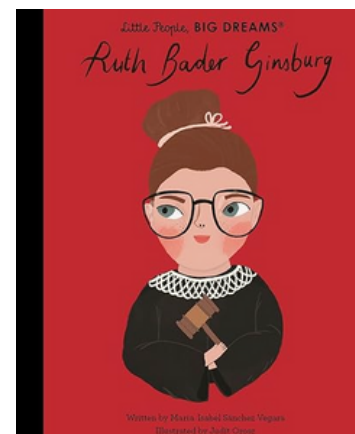
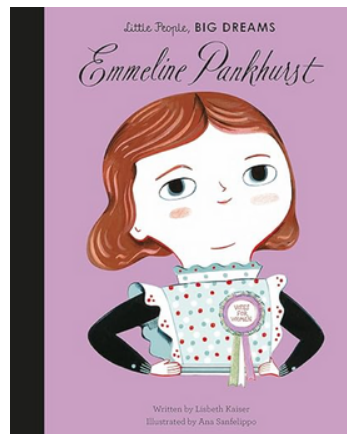


## THE HIGHWAY RAT
