Project Description

In the Autumn Two term, Zayit and Seorah classes will be working on a very exciting project linked to our topic of 'All Around the World'. We will be focused on learning related to our big question: 'How are countries around the world different?' Through the term, we will develop our Geography, Expressive Arts and Technology knowledge and skills as we learn more about our own country and a range of different countries around the world. We are going to have four different countries to focus on; India, South Africa, Japan and Israel. We will link learning to developing our life skills in three areas; 'Learning about a country', 'Learning about a religion' and 'Using cutlery'. There will be a focus on using our oral language skills to share the knowledge that we gain with our friends and community. At the conclusion of our project, Zayit and Seorah will host a Travel Show exhibition for the other classes at Geshur School to share our Country Fact Files and Travel Vlogs. These will be a result of all the information we have researched and recorded linked to the countries we learn about and will be a fun way to use our oral language skills with technology.
