Celebrating Mitzvah Day

Last week on Monday 21st November 2022, the children embraced the Jewish value of giving and caring for others by engaging in Mitzvah Day. The students participated in different activities to support communities in both the UK and Israel. They made cards for the 'Save a Child's Heart' charity which helps young people who have either undergone or will undergo heart surgery. Also, they made collages for ADI which is a residential center in Israel that looks after children with profound disabilities. They all created their own bird feeders after learning that a lot of birds struggle to source food and water during the winter months and embellished tissue boxes for Jewish Women's Aid.

In the afternoon, we invited our primary school parents into Gesher to assist with decorating biscuits/cupcakes for the children to sell in the hall. Everyone enjoyed showcasing their creations and raising money for a charity of their choice.



The children voted to donate to the Israel Guide Dog Centre and we raised over £200! Through our new tzedakah initiative in school, we hope to continue to raise money for this charity until the end of term

This initiative encourages the children to give tzedakah every Friday before Shabbat, which is an important mitzvah in Judaism that we want to practice within our school community.
