

SYNAGOGUE SOCIAL STORY

Sometimes, I go to the synagogue with my family.



When the service starts, I need to make sure that I sit down and listen. When I walk around the room, it distracts other people.



I can use the Siddur to look at to help me to follow the service.



After the service, when everyone is sitting down and talking, I can join in the conversation.



If I don't want to join in with the conversation, that is okay. I can go to the other room to play.



When I am playing on my own, I should not sing or run around the room. This will distract other people from talking and listening to each other. Sometimes mummy finds it hard to listen when I am too loud.



If mummy and daddy tell me to be quiet, I should listen. Other people in the synagogue try to listen and use indoor voices when they speak.
