

PBL Exhibition Workshop

On Wednesday, Tiferet Class launched the school-wide PBL Exhibition with R.E.A.C.H Link to poster - workshops. Families were invited to the school to explore and interact with workshops the students designed and launched. Students toured parents up the stairwell to see the mural Tiferet class designed and created to display the importance of creativity and collaboration. Parents then explored the multiple different workshops students designed for each school value. Students created a Respect human board game where parents explored ways that we demonstrate respect. Tiferet class created an Accept workshop where they displayed neurodivergence strengths and challenges icebergs to highlight the importance of accepting ourselves and others to understand our challenges and celebrate our strengths. Students organised a question and answer session with parents for the Care workshop that focused on how we care for ourselves and others through a fun and interactive interview. They also set up an Honour station where parents were encouraged to explore how we take care of our mental and physical





wellbeing through engaging in a variety of mindfulness activities. We ended our exhibition with our final workshop focusing on Engage where everyone engaged in a variety of games the students developed to demonstrate how they engage with their learning and the world around them.

Overall, the exhibition was a wonderful reflection of what Tiferet class has been exploring over this term and the students were so proud of themselves for what they accomplished.
