Core Substantive Knowledge

Belonging to a Community – What different groups do we belong to in our community?

Children learn:

- The importance of being a part of different groups, and the role they play in these groups e.g. class, teams, faith groups
- The different rights and responsibilities that they have in school and the wider community
- How a community can help people from different groups to feel included
- To recognise that they are all equal, and ways in which they are the same and different to others in their community

Key Vocabulary

Belonging, community, group, support, rights, fairness, respect, kindness, acceptance, similar, different, unique

Key Questions

- What does it mean to belong?
- What are my rights and why are they important?
- How can everyone be included?
- What makes you unique?

Media literacy and Digital resilience – How can we use the internet in everyday life?

Children learn:

- The ways in which people can access the internet e.g. phones, tablets, computers
- To recognise the purpose and value of the internet in everyday life
- To recognise that some content on the internet is factual and some is for entertainment e.g. news, games, videos
- That information online might not always be true

Device, computer, internet, tablet, smartphone, computer, QR code, misinformation, source / credible source, disinformation

- How can we access the internet safely?
- What are the benefits of using the internet?
- How can we check if a story is true?

Money and Work – How can we look after our money and spend it wisely?

Children learn:

- What money is and its different forms e.g. coins, notes, and ways of paying for things e.g. debit cards, electronic payments
- How money can be kept and looked after
- About getting, keeping and spending money
- That people are paid money for the job they do

Money, coins, notes, spending, saving, jobs, needs, wants.

- How can we look after money?
- Where does money come from?
- What is the difference between a need and a want?

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
