Local children's author Lisa J Allen visited school this week for an inspiring and creative day with Year 5 and 6. The visit began with an assembly, where Lisa spoke about her journey as an author, encouraged pupils to believe they could be authors too and answered lots of thoughtful questions.

After the assembly, Lisa signed copies of her books before leading imaginative workshops with each class. During the sessions, pupils used their creativity to design their own characters and explore storytelling ideas.

Lisa is the author of the *Undercover Angel* series, a comedy fantasy adventure for ages 9-12. The story follows trainee angel Phoebe Speedwell as she tackles a top-secret mission in the human world, juggling magic, mystery and the challenges of tween life!



## DISCO DROP OFF AND COLLECTION ARRANGEMENTS

Last week we shared information around the new collection arrangements for our discos. Although the drop off and collection logistics have changed, **the timings for next week's disco have remained the same** as they have been previously. Here is a reminder below:

### EYFS & KS1 – Collection (4:15pm Finish)

Children in EYFS and KS1 will continue to be collected as *usual* from the playground when the disco finishes at **4:15pm**.

### KS2 Drop-Off and Collection

#### Drop-Off (6.30pm)

- KS2 children will now be dropped off in the playground. The **front gate will be open** to allow access to the playground.
- Please note: **the back gate will be locked**.
- A member of staff will register all children in their classrooms before accompanying them down to the hall.

#### Collection (7.30pm)

- At the end of the disco, KS2 children will be taken back to their classrooms. Parents and carers can then collect them safely from the playground.

### New KS2 Disco Time (from Summer Term)

Beginning in the summer term, the timings for the KS1 disco will remain the same but the KS2 disco will be earlier.

The timings for future discos will be:

KS1 - 3.15pm - 4.15pm

KS2 - 5pm - 6pm

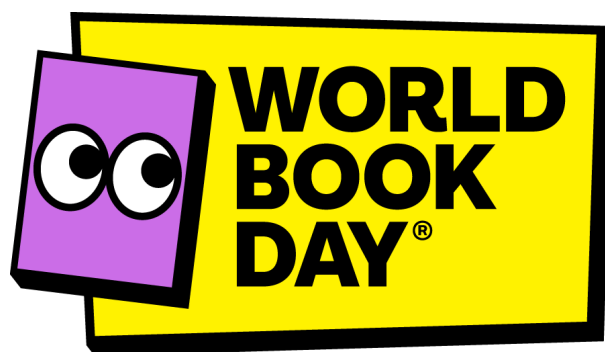

## ROAD SAFETY

Thank you to everyone who has adhered to the new car parking system! This has made the car park much safer for our children and community.

We would like to remind parents to park considerately on the neighbouring roads. Unfortunately, we continue to see vehicles parked too close to junctions and driveways causing obstructions. Please be reminded that inconsiderate parking may be in breach of **Highway Code Rule 243** which states:

***Do not stop opposite or within 10 metres (32 feet) of a junction, except in an authorised parking space.***

We fully understand that drop-off and pick-up times can be busy and that many families rely on cars however, it is essential that all members of our community park safely, legally and respectfully ensuring junctions and residents' driveways remain clear at all times.
