So walk with pride to what comes next, stand tall in who you are— you'll never be measured by numbers, but by the light you carry far.

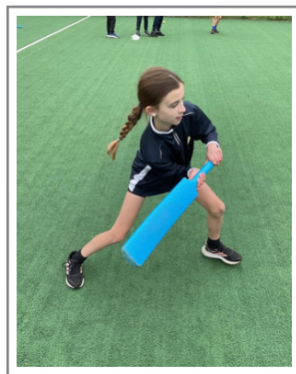
When you leave our school in Year 6, remember this is true: the world won't judge your greatness by a score...

JEWELLERY AND SMART WATCH REMINDERS

We would like to remind parents that, for health and safety reasons, earrings should not be worn in school. The only exception is small stud earrings, which may be worn for up to six weeks following ear piercing to allow time for healing. After this period, all earrings should be removed during the school day.

We also remind parents that smart watches of any kind should not be worn in school. A smart watch is a digital watch that can do much more than tell the time. Many smart watches can connect to the internet (such as Wi-Fi or mobile networks) and may have features similar to a mobile phone, including messaging, phone calls, taking photographs, recording video or audio, tracking location, and accessing apps or games. For this reason they should not be worn in school.
