We hope you enjoyed visiting their new classrooms and looking at their work from the day. I think it is safe to say we have lots of excited children!



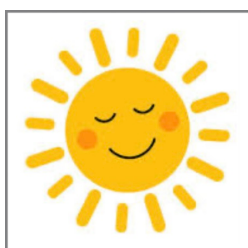
SUN SAFETY

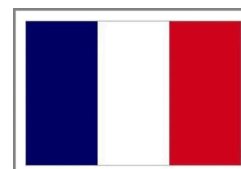
BASTILLE DAY!
