
Supporting **Asylum Seeker** and Refugee Carers

Newcastle is recognised as a City of Sanctuary, committed to welcoming refugees and those seeking sanctuary and helping them to rebuild their lives. Many people seeking sanctuary are caring for someone.

A carer is someone who looks after another person, usually a family member or friend, who could not manage without their support due to illness, disability, mental health problems or an addiction.

Asylum seekers and refugees often face complex caring situations and do not access the information, advice and entitlements they need to help them in their caring role. At Newcastle Carers, we have an Asylum Seekers and Refugees Worker to provide dedicated support.

They can:

- Work with asylum seekers and refugees in Newcastle to build trusted relationships.

- Provide information, advice and support at a time and place and in ways that meet asylum seekers' and refugees' needs.
- Focus on ways to help reduce the negative impacts of asylum seekers' and refugees' caring responsibilities.
