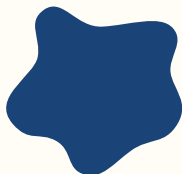

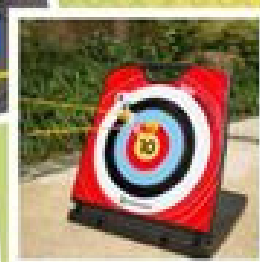

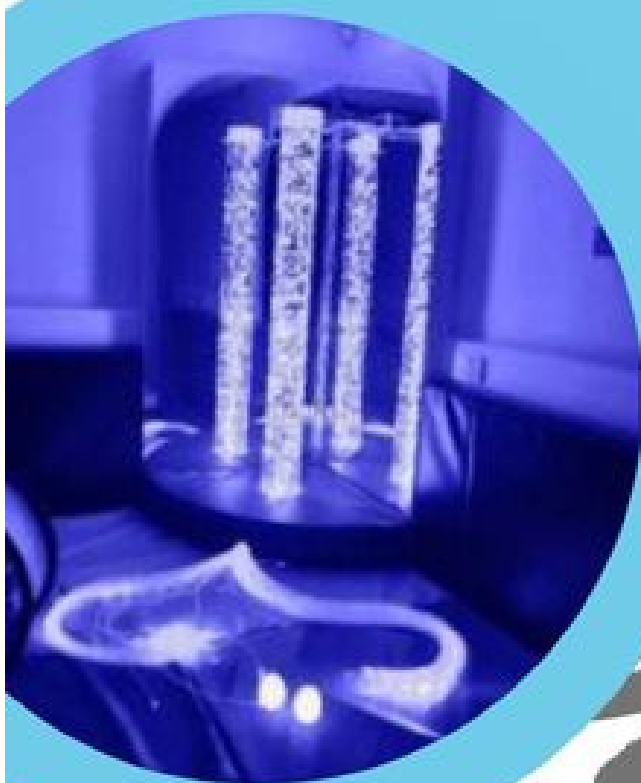

SOCIAL HOUSING

Newcastle Homes advises due to the current demand for social housing and the lack of available properties, it is not possible to offer all households on the housing register a property.

Newcastle Homes have informed us that of the 24,885 council properties in Newcastle

- * 51% are Houses
- * 42% are Flats
- * 6% are Bungalows

Housing Register

8,977 families are currently registered on the housing register (as of February 2024)

- * 574 need 4 or more bedrooms
- * 1,493 need 3 bedrooms
- * 4,394 need 1 bedroom

According to Newcastle Homes if no new applicants applied, it would take nearly 5 years to re-house everyone on the register.

Waiting Times

From October 22 - October 23 Newcastle Homes state the average waiting times were

- Band A - 11 weeks
- Band B - 28 weeks
- Band C - 49 weeks
- Band D - 64 weeks

Waiting time for 4 bed property

- Band A - 25 weeks
- Band B - 77 weeks

Waiting time for 5 bed property

- Band A - 15 weeks
- Band B - 28 weeks

There are increased waiting times across all priority bands due to more households actively bidding and more applications being awarded Band B status

Newcastle Homes are advising
applicants to be realistic with the
length of time they may wait for an
offer of a property. They are
encouraging applicants to explore
other available options. This is
especially relevant to Band D
applicants, who are unlikely to be
offered housing.

If you are already a council or
housing association tenant you may
find it quicker to be rehoused by
'swapping' your home with another
tenant through mutual exchange. You
can enquire from Newcastle Homes
or check out housing swap groups
on Facebook.

The Private Rented Service run by
Newcastle Cit Council support tenants
in the private rented sector.

They offer a Home Finder Service,
Rent Deposit Guarantee Scheme and
free professional advice.

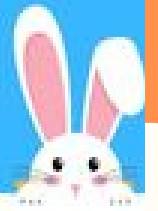
